▶ FLOURISH VISION

The heart of FLOURISH is to see the women of PCC & the Grove be firmly rooted in Jesus and the living Word of God. We believe a mentoring relationship between an older and younger woman can be rich soil for such growth. Flourish will connect older women with younger women in a curriculum based mentoring relationship to encourage and challenge one another in their walk with Jesus.

▶ COMMITMENT

1 year commitment January to December

We ask mentors and mentees to meet individually/face to face once a month, and one group meeting every other month.

This is the basic expectation we ask them to stick to. Once mentor and mentee get to know one another better they can add more opportunities to meet if they'd like.

▶ CURRICULUM
